Colorectal cancer can be beat. Unlike many other cancers, this disease can be stopped in its tracks with a simple screening test. Colon cancer starts in the large intestine (colon) or the rectum (end of the colon). A diagnostic test called colonoscopy is performed to screen for precancerous polyps. During the test, polyps can frequently be removed, preventing the disease. While so many other types of cancer are only found when the disease has progressed, colorectal cancer can be stopped before it even starts.

The good news is death rates for colorectal cancer have dropped in the last 15 years. This is due to increased awareness, screening and improved treatment. However, more lives could be saved if people could afford to have a colonoscopy. By joining this effort, you will help to raise the funds that will provide financial grants to patients who need, but cannot afford the prevention that can and will save lives.

It's time to act. Every man and woman over the age of 50 needs to have a colonoscopy.
