

Here is Richard's story.

Richard's life changed instantly. He went from being calm and feeling good one minute to not knowing what was happening to his body. He had a heart attack. With fluid on his lungs and four ulcers in his stomach, things went downhill fast. He was unable to have heart surgery until doctors were able to determine exactly what was going on. After numerous biopsies, labs and x-rays, on April 30th, it was discovered that he had cancer. Hodgkin's Lymphoma is not what Richard wanted to hear. Unable to drive, he relied on his children for transportation to his chemo treatments, which were 80 miles away. Due to the recent coronavirus outbreak, he was unable to go to his treatments. During this time, his port became infected and caused him to have sepsis. Needless to say, this is a very scary time for Richard. The CoxHealth Foundation assisted Richard with travel mileage and medical expenses.
