If that wasn't hard enough, she also suffered from diabetes. Jean had several surgeries and chemotherapy over a number of years, hoping for healing. Thanks to the Knot Forgotten program, Jean received the help she needed during her treatment. Before she passed she called to express her gratitude and sent this letter to the CoxHealth Foundation:
