*For the first time ever the NICU will contain:*

- 25 Private rooms
- Rooming in options for mom and dad
- A transition room to allow parents to overnight with their child, with staff at hand, before heading home
- A private lactation room
- A lab and respiratory therapy room inside the unit
- Nurse touchdown stations which allow nurses to be in constant view of their babies
- A private garden area for families to enjoy the outdoors with their baby
